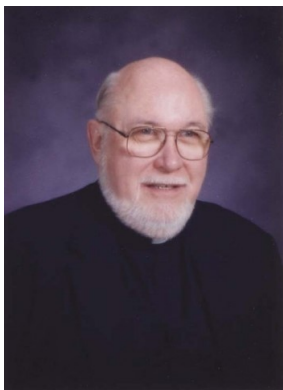


# Deacon Study Day

### Rev. Ronald C. Chochol



Fr. Ronald Chochol was ordained a priest in the Archdiocese of St. Louis in 1964 and joined the Sulpicians. He has taught in seminaries in Menlo Park, California, and Baltimore, Maryland. In 1979, he was awarded a doctorate in philosophy and anthropology from the University of Toronto. Fr. Chochol has held several academic posts throughout his ministry, including rector of the seminary college in Baltimore, academic dean at Weston Jesuit School of Theology, academic dean at St. Meinrad School of Theology and instructor in philosophy and theology at Kenrick Seminary. Additionally, he has served as a pastor, director of Continuing Education for Priests, a teacher of theology in the Pastoral Institute, chair of the Priests' Council and the CCHD Committee, and member of several archdiocesan committees. In 2011, Fr. Chochol retired as pastor, though he continues to serve in parishes in the archdiocese. In 2013, he joined the Global Fellows and traveled to Kenya.
